Introduction

In this guide we will show you the process for installing our OS Commerce module. This module is used to integration us as a payment option that your customers can choose upon checkout from your store.

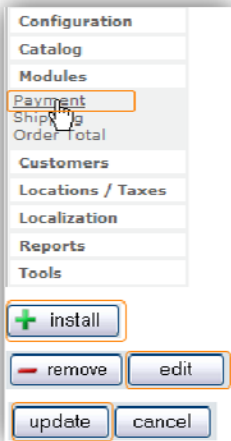
Please note that this guide assumes you already have OS Commerce installed on your server and simply looking for assistance adding/configuring our module. If you have not done this then you will need to complete this process before continuing. You can download OS Commerce and find installation instructions on their site <http://addons.oscommerce.com/info/6220>.

Obtaining/Extracting the module and placing it on your server

You should have received an email from our client support staff that contains a zip file **EC Suite.zip** with the Module inside it. If you have not received this you may contact support who will gladly send it to you.

- 1) Once you have the zip document you will need to unzip the files locally onto your PC.
- 2) You should now see an **EC Suite** folder in the location you chose to unzip the contents to. Inside this folder there is another folder called **Includes**. Because our module does not re-write any of the core OS Commerce system files you may upload the entire **Includes** folder to the root of your store's installation.

Configuring the Module inside OS Commerce



Now that you have placed the files onto your ftp server it is time to install and setup the payment module inside the administration section of OS Commerce. Please follow the steps below to complete this process.

1. Access the Administration section of OS Commerce.
2. Click Modules on the left.
3. Under Payment, Click the **EC Suite Dynamic Pricing** module to highlight it.
4. Click **Install** (on the right).
5. Click **Edit**.
6. Fill out the required sections with the information you have received from EC Suite (Client Acnum, Client Subacc, Form Name, and Salt.)

Note: If you don't know this information please contact Client Support.

7. Click **Update**.

Your Module is now setup and your consumers should be able to see this option when checking out.

Set-Up Approval & Denial URL's and 3-Second Redirect

Now that the module has been setup on your server you must complete 1 additional step. In order for your store to know that a payment was successful you will need to ensure that the Approval and Denial URLs are correctly setup inside the system.

Client support will need to enable an internal feature called "3 second redirect". This ensures that the consumers are sent back to the approval URL therefore making the payment complete in your system. You may use the email below to inform client support of the required changes.


